### Dates and location

- Cadets and Officers are invited to participate in the Annual Cadets Camp, conducted this year on the weekend of Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> through to Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2026.
- The camp will be held at outdoor adventure camps in Wisemans Ferry. The address is 256 Webbs Creek Rd, Wisemans Ferry 2775

### Arrival and pick-up times

- Members can arrive / be dropped off no earlier than 1800HRS (6:00PM) on Friday.
- Please wear your Full Parade Uniform when arriving on Friday.
- Members are to arrive on-site and register no later than 2115HRS (9:15PM) on Friday.
- Parents are encouraged to arrive by 1445HRS (2:45PM) on Sunday to witness the final parade and collect members.

### Guest attendance & adult attendance

- Parents and caregivers are permitted to attend with prior approval. Please co-ordinate this request through your Unit Commanding Officer.
- All adults, regardless of membership (i.e., Parents / Carers), must have a valid Working with Children Check to attend this camp. No WWCC = No Camp.

### Transport & Parking arrangements

- The camp is located at 256 Webbs Creek Rd, Wisemans Ferry 2775 and can be accessed via carpark
- On Sunday, we ask that parents / caregivers arrive between 1430HRS (02:30PM) and 1500HRS (3:00PM) and park their vehicle in designated spots.
- Parents are invited to watch the final parade which will begin at 1500HRS (3:00PM) and be dismissed at 1530 (3:30PM).

### Accommodation arrangements

- Members attending the camp will sleep in bunk-style accommodation, sleeping up to 8 per room with a shared bathroom.
- Members must bring their own bedding (pillow and sleeping bag or blankets).

### Meal arrangements

- All meals will be catered for throughout the weekend, commencing Friday with late night Supper and concluding with Lunch on Sunday.
- Attendees will need to ensure they eat dinner before arriving on Friday.
- Please list all dietary requirements on your form and include any allergies or foods that cannot be eaten.

### Registration & Cost

- The cost for the weekend is \$160 per person and includes all meals, accommodation and activities.
- Registration and a 50% deposit of \$80 is required by the 24<sup>th</sup> April 2026.
- Full Payment is required by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2026
- The camp application form must be completed before Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2026. You can complete the application form by going to [cadets.org.au/activityform](https://cadets.org.au/activityform). Or ask your Unit C.O for a paper form. **No form = no camp.**
- Please organise payment for this camp through your Cadet Unit by the due date.
- A fundraising canteen will be available during the camp for members to purchase snacks and Cadets Merchandise.

### Activities

- Activities conducted during the weekend may include and are not limited to
  - Fieldcraft / Orienteering
  - Night / War /Strategy Games
  - Ball games – Soccer, Cricket, Tennis, etc
  - Drill Training
  - Band Training
  - Leadership Training
- Attendees may also bring games and activities to use during free time (cards, small board games, etc)
- No electronics are permitted at this camp. Do not bring phones, Gameboys, iPads, etc.

- All personal items should be marked clearly for identification purposes.
- Do not pack snacks, lollies, or food of any kind. A meal plan has been organised.
- Do not pack any product using a spray dispenser.
- No open shoes are permitted. Only fully enclosed shoes are permitted.

### Important information

- Cadets and Officers must wear their Full Parade Uniform when arriving to camp on Friday.
- We want everyone to attend. Anyone experiencing financial trouble or cannot provide their own equipment should speak to their Unit Commanding Officer, assistance may be available.
- The temperature throughout May in Wisemans ferry is expected to range between 20°C and 10°C with rain expected 6 out of 31 days. Please ensure you pack appropriately.
- Any medications required to be taken throughout the camp must be labelled appropriately and provided to the Camp First Aid Officer during registration, please ensure medications are not packed in luggage.
- In a medical emergency, attendees will be conveyed to the nearest Public Hospital. In this case, it would be Hawkesbury District Hospital We have an Officer attending with relevant first aid training.
